- The NAACA board has met with county officials on multiple occasions this year to insure that zoning and codes are maintained according to the Paseo Del Norte Sector Plan and that we maintain the lifestyle we all appreciate in NAA.
- We organized a community Spring Clean Up and will repeat this activity in 2010. This allows residents the opportunity to rid themselves of excess trash, appliances, and hazardous waste in one trip!
- We met with developers determined to change the character of our community and showed a determined front against un-controlled development – there is strength in an(our) association!
