

Sec. 66-221. Setback area use.

The setback area may be used for the following public purposes so long as such uses are not in conflict with the provisions of this article or any other applicable ordinance:

- (1) Street furniture.
- (2) Public and private utility distribution systems.
- (3) Planting of trees and/or other suitable types of vegetation, as described in section

66-223(a)(6).

- (4) Decorative paving or other ground cover not intended for vehicular use.
- (5) Drivepad and/or driveway access.
- (6) Bicycle trails.
- (7) Drainage or borrow ditches.
- (8) Mailboxes.
- (9) Traffic control devices.

- (6) ... trees possessing the following characteristics:
 - a. Adaptability to the particular soil, climate and moisture conditions of this county;
 - b. High resistance to gas, smoke, and disease;
 - c. Freedom from litter and offensive odors;
 - d. Wood that is not brittle and thereby easily broken by wind and sleet;
 - e. A root structure compatible with planting in confined areas; and
 - f. Long normal life.
